1 Amend Bill, page 2, line 2, by striking out "and coinsurance"

2 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 12 through 15, by striking out all
3 of said lines

4 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 18 through 22, by striking out "may
5 not subject an insured to more than" in line 18 and all of lines
6 19 through 22 and inserting

7 for services provided by a licensed physical therapist,
8 chiropractor or occupational therapist provider, may not subject
9 an insured to more than one copayment amount per visit or
10 deplete more than one visit.
11 Section 1004-B. Regulations.

12 The department may promulgate regulations as may be necessary
13 or appropriate to carry out the provisions of this article.
14 Section 1005-B. Penalties.

15 A violation of this article by an insurer if committed
16 flagrantly and in conscious disregard of the provisions of this
17 article or with frequency sufficient to constitute a general
18 business practice shall be considered a violation of the act of
19 July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), known as the Unfair Insurance
20 Practices Act. A violation of this article is deemed an unfair
21 method of competition and an unfair deceptive act or practice
22 pursuant to the Unfair Insurance Practices Act.
