

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 1003 Printer's No. 1382

Committee: Banking and Insurance

SYNOPSIS:

Amends the Insurance Company Law of 1921 providing for reimbursement for emergency medical services.

SUMMARY:

Amends current law requiring reimbursement for emergency medical services to prohibit a managed care plan from denying a claim solely because the enrollee was not transported or refused to be transported.

Requires Medicaid to pay for the same services required under this act and requires sufficient funds be appropriated each fiscal year for the payment of the services.

Effective Date: 60 days
